

Employability Services

- National service dedicated to improving employment outcomes for jobseekers with disabilities
- For jobseekers closer to the labour market / “work ready”

Workability

- Funds 57 local, regional and national projects which provide pathways into employment for people with disabilities.
- For people who want to work but need further skills / training to do so



Work Placement Experience Programme - WPEP



- 6-month work placement provided by the company
- Participant is mentored by the company while on placement
- Participant engages in formal accredited training while on placement
- No waiting period for DA recipients



Work Placement Experience Programme - WPEP



- Opportunity to engage new talent
- Access fresh thinking
- Capacity building for employer
- Staff development
- No financial cost to employer
- Identify future employees

Wage Subsidy Scheme



- Financial incentive to employ persons with a disability
- Employer must be non-public sector employer
- Rate starts at **€6.30 per hour**
- Employees must work for a **minimum of 15 hours** per week
- Subsidy is paid for a **maximum of 39 hours** per week
- **Additional funding** where 3+ employees are on the scheme

WSS – 2026 Budget Updates



Number of employees On WSS	Percentage increase	Subsidy rate per hour (April 2026)
1 to 6	N/A	€7.50
7 to 16	13% increase	€8.50
17 +	33% increase	€10.00

Scheme Extension

Wage Subsidy Scheme will be extended from January 2026 to more people who acquire a disability.

	Support Type	Grant Amount
1	Workplace Needs Assessment	€2,500
2	Communication Support	Varies
3	Personal Reader	€12,500
4	In-Work Support	€12,500
5	Work Equipment	€12,000 x 2
6	Workplace Adaptation	€25,000
7	Disability Awareness Training	€20,000
